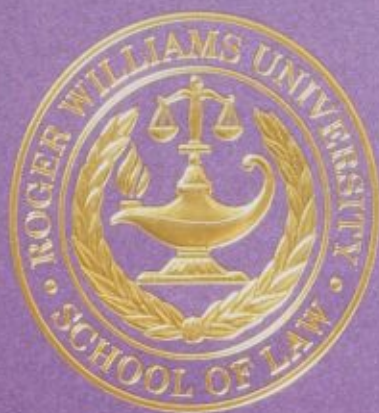

Doctor of Laws Honoris Causa

Supreme Court Correspondent, The New York Times

B.A. Radcliffe College

M.S. Yale Law School



Linda Greenhouse has been the Supreme Court correspondent for The New York Times for three decades. In 1968, she graduated from Radcliffe College at Harvard University, where she served as an editor of the Harvard Crimson and was elected to Phi Beta Kappa. In 1978, she earned a master of studies in law at Yale Law School, where she attended on a Ford Foundation fellowship. In January 2009, Ms. Greenhouse will return to Yale as the Knight distinguished journalist-in-residence and Joseph M. Goldstein senior fellow.

For her coverage of the Supreme Court, Ms. Greenhouse was awarded the Pulitzer Prize in journalism in 1998. Her biography of Justice Harry A. Blackmun, *Becoming Justice Blackmun*, was published in 2005 by Times Books/Henry Holt. Ms. Greenhouse is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, where she serves on the council; an honorary member of the American Law Institute; and a member of the American Philosophical Society,

which in 2005 awarded her its Henry Allen Moe Prize for writing in the humanities and jurisprudence. In addition, she is a past vice president of the Women's Forum of Washington, D.C., and serves on the council of the Schlesinger Library on the History of American Women at Harvard's Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study.

Ms. Greenhouse has lectured at many universities, law schools and judicial conferences, and she has appeared regularly since 1980 on the PBS program "Washington Week." During the 2004 and 2005 academic years, she lectured at universities and colleges around the country as a Phi Beta Kappa visiting scholar. She was awarded the Radcliffe Medal and the Barnard College Medal of Distinction in 2006. In 2007, she received the Yale Law School Association's Award of Merit, the law school's highest honor.

Ms. Greenhouse lives in Bethesda, Md., with her husband, Eugene R. Fidell, a lawyer in Washington, D.C., who specializes in military law and also serves as president of the National Institute of Military Justice. Their daughter, Hannah, is a recent graduate of Indiana University.

Ms. Greenhouse, your extraordinary contributions to public understanding of the law and the American legal system have enriched and inspired lawyers and non-lawyers alike, and we are honored to award you this Doctor of Laws, honoris causa.

THE HONORABLE PHILLIP RAPOZA

Doctor of Laws Honoris Causa

Chief Justice, Massachusetts Appeals Court

B.A. Yale College

J.D. Cornell Law School



Chief Justice Phillip Rapoza currently serves as presiding justice of the Massachusetts Appeals Court, but his contributions to the law span both domestic and international domains.

As an attorney, the Chief Justice practiced as an assistant district attorney in the Suffolk and Bristol County District Attorney's Offices, and later in Fall River and New Bedford law firms concentrating primarily on criminal defense work. Appointed as a judge to the Fall River District Court in 1992, Chief Justice Rapoza served for four years before moving to the Superior Court, where he remained until his appointment to the Appeals Court in 1998.

From 2003 to 2005, Chief Justice Rapoza was the sole U.S. judge on the Special Panels for Serious Crimes, a war crimes tribunal established by the United Nations to deal with crimes against humanity and other human rights violations committed in East Timor during that country's quest for independence. Within three months of his appointment, he was promoted to chief administrative judge of the panel. David Cohen, executive director of the Berkeley War Crimes Studies Center, wrote that "few other individuals have played such a key role in any of the international courts" as Chief Justice Rapoza, who "is now considered by many international experts to be one of the very best."

The Chief Justice remains actively involved in international legal matters. He recently visited Cambodia, where he lectured on crimes against humanity to senior attorneys who will appear before the recently established Khmer Rouge war crimes tribunal. He also serves as chairman of the Commission for Justice Across the Atlantic, which promotes closer ties between the legal systems of Portugal and the United States.

The grandson of Portuguese immigrants from the Azores, Chief Justice Rapoza is one of only two Portuguese-American judges in Massachusetts, and he continues to speak extensively and proudly about his Portuguese heritage. In recognition of his international work, President Jorge Sampaio of Portugal awarded him the rank of commander in the Order of Prince Henry the Navigator in 2002.

Chief Justice Rapoza, your dedication to the law, your community and human rights around the world serves as an example to all of our graduates, and we are honored to award you this Doctor of Laws, honoris causa.
