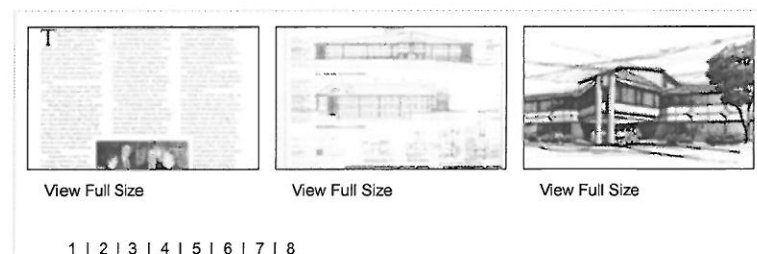

“There is almost a universal belief that Rhode Island is badly served by the lack of a law school. In addition to educating aspiring lawyers, [a law school would] enhance the delivery of legal services in the state by becoming the focal point for legal reform, legal research and continuing legal education of the bar” – *The Honorable Joseph Weisberger, 1990*

**1990** Roger Williams College President Natale Sicuro appoints a blue-ribbon committee to explore the feasibility of establishing a law school at Roger Williams College.



**1991** The Honorable Joseph Weisberger, as chair of the exploratory committee, officially recommends that Roger Williams College establish a law school, based upon an intensive “Feasibility Study to Establish a Law School” prepared by Anthony Santoro, then Dean and Professor of Law at Widener University School of Law.



**1992** Dean Anthony Santoro is appointed as RWU Law's founding dean. Construction of law building begins. Faculty recruiting begins. In May, Roger Williams College is renamed **Roger Williams University**, partially as a result of its decision to add a law school.

**1993** The School of Law opens. Its first class, the Class of 1996, consists of 110 full-time (Day Division) students, and 74 Extended Division students. Breakdown is 56 percent Rhode Islanders, and 44 percent from out of state; they were chosen from among 600 applicants.

**Dean Anthony Santoro** is named President of Roger Williams University, effective August 23.

**John E. Ryan** is appointed **Dean**, effective September 7. Ryan was former dean of McGeorge Law School in Sacramento, Calif., and a two-term chair of the American Bar Association's accreditation committee.

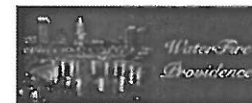

**1995**

Chief Justice Joseph Weisberger commences the tradition of the Justices of the **Rhode Island Supreme Court** presiding over the final rounds of the annual **Moot Court Competition**. Weisberger was joined by the Honorable Florence K. Murray, the Honorable Donald F. Shea, and the Honorable Victoria Lederberg.

RWU Law is awarded **provisional accreditation** from the American Bar Association.



**1996**

*Roger Williams University School of Law Review* publishes its inaugural issue.

Inaugural Commencement held May 18, with U.S. Supreme Court Associate Justice **Anthony Kennedy** as commencement speaker. There are 87 Day Division graduates (Extended Division students from the first class would graduate in 1997).

**Marine Affairs Institute** is established, July 29.

**The Feinstein Institute for Legal Service**, the hub of RWU Law's public service initiatives, is established with a \$1 million donation from Rhode Island philanthropist Alan Shawn Feinstein on September 9.



**1997**

RWU Law is awarded **full accreditation** by the American Bar Association. At the time, it is the fastest law school accreditation in ABA history.



**Clark Moot Court Competition** named for Distinguished Visiting Professor Esther Clark (1929-2002), a pioneering litigator and popular teacher in the school's early years.

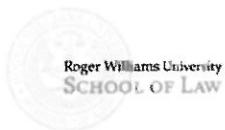


**1999**

**2001** Founding Dean and former Roger Williams University President Anthony Santoro rejoins RWU Law as faculty member.

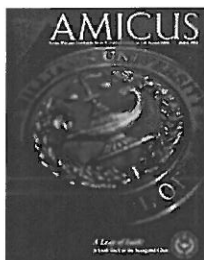

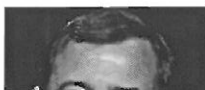
