THE HONORABLE MADELEINE K. ALBRIGHT The 64th U.S. Secretary of State

Doctor of Laws Honoris Causa

Madeleine K. Albright is Chair of Albright Stonebridge Group, a global strategy firm, and Albright Capital Management, an investment advisory firm.

In 1997, Dr. Albright was named the 64th U.S. Secretary of State, becoming the first female to hold the position and, at the time, the highest ranking woman in the history of the U.S. government. As Secretary of State, Dr. Albright reinforced America's alliances, advocated for democracy and human rights, and promoted American trade, business, labor and environmental standards abroad. For those efforts, she will receive the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the nation's highest civilian honor, from President Obama later this spring.

Dr. Albright is a Professor in the Practice of Diplomacy at the Georgetown University School of Foreign Service. She chairs both the National Democratic Institute for International Affairs and the Pew Global Attitudes Project and serves as president of the Truman Scholarship Foundation. She serves on the U.S. Department of Defense's Defense Policy Board, a group tasked with providing the Secretary of Defense with independent, informed advice and opinion concerning matters of defense policy.

Dr. Albright is the author of five New York Times bestsellers including her renowned autobiography, *Madam Secretary: A Memoir* (2003), and her most recent book, *Prague Winter: A Personal Story of Remembrance and War*, 1937-1948, released in April 2012.

Dr. Albright holds a bachelor of arts with honors from Wellesley College and master's and doctorate degrees from Columbia University's Department of Public Law and Government, as well as a certificate from its Russian Institute.



TRUDY COXE

Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director,
The Preservation Society of Newport County

Doctor of Humane Letters Honoris Causa

Trudy Coxe joined The Preservation Society of Newport County in December 1998. She oversees more than 400 employees and has grown the organization's operating budget from \$9 million to \$16 million annually. Under her leadership, visitation has also increased, with more than 900,000 visits annually, as have membership, fundraising and retail sales.

During Ms. Coxe's tenure, 10 of the Society's properties have been designated as Official Projects of Save America's Treasures, a partnership between the White House Millennium Council and the National Trust for Historic Preservation. In April 2004, the Society received accreditation by the American Association of Museums; only 750 of the nation's 16,000 museums are accredited.

From 1993 to 1998, Ms. Coxe served as Massachusetts Secretary of Environmental Affairs. Previously, she was Executive Director of Rhode Island's Save the Bay for 11 years, turning it into the largest citizen action organization in New England. She also served for two years as Director of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management in the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

Among her more recent honors, Coxe was the recipient of a 2006 Award of Excellence from National Garden Clubs, Inc. for her lifetime of environmental advocacy, and the 2001 Mary Brennan Tourism Award from the Rhode Island Hospitality and Tourism Association.

Coxe's volunteer involvement is extensive. Among many roles, she currently serves on the boards of the National Recreation and Park Association, the Appalachian Mountain Club, Grow Smart Rhode Island, the Metcalf Institute for Marine & Environmental Reporting, the Wheeler School, the Newport County Chamber of Commerce, and Child and Family Services.

Diplomas and official transcripts are issued to graduates only after all degree requirements are met. All degrees and honors are certified by the University Registrar. Honorary distinction, awarded to students who have met the residency requirement (54 credits), are based upon final cumulative grade point averages:

Summa cum laude - 3.8

Magna cum laude - 3.6

Cum laude - 3.4

The standard academic costume used today has its roots as far back as medieval times, when gowns were worn daily in European universities to identify disciplines of study and provide warmth. In 1895, American campuses adopted

the formal Academic Costume Code based on this historical precedent. The code allows the audience to determine from the costume the degree, academic discipline, and often the institution that awarded the degree.

The academic costume consists of a cap with a tassel, a gown and a hood. The tassel may be in the color of the major field of study, or in gold signifying a doctor. Different tassels are worn by those graduating with honors: white for summa cum laude; white and blue for magna cum laude; and blue for cum laude. The gowns range from unornamental for a bachelor; to longer sleeves for a master: to more ornamental, with three bands on the sleeve and front panel, for a doctor. The hood is bordered in the color of the major field of study and lined in the color of the institution which awarded the degree.

Variations from this standard may indicate academic costuming from foreign universities, or a specific expression of a group or individual. The standard academic color code follows.
