Frank J. Fahrenkopf, Jr., is president and CEO of the American Gaming Association (AGA). In his role as the chief executive of the AGA, Fahrenkopf is the national advocate for the

commercial casino industry and is responsible for positioning the association to address regulatory, political and educational issues affecting the industry.

A lawyer by profession, Fahrenkopf gained national prominence during the 1980s when he served as chairman of the Republican Party for six of President Ronald Reagan's eight years in the White House (1983 to 1989). When Fahrenkopf retired in January 1989, he had served as chairman longer than any person in the 20th century (and second-longest in the history of the party) and led the party through two successful presidential campaigns in 1984 and 1988. Currently, Fahrenkopf is co-chairman of the Commission on Presidential Debates. He has been a frequent commentator on political and gaming issues on such programs as "Crossfire", "Inside Politics", "Meet The Press", "Hardball", "Face the Nation", "The Today Show", "This Week" and "Good Morning America."

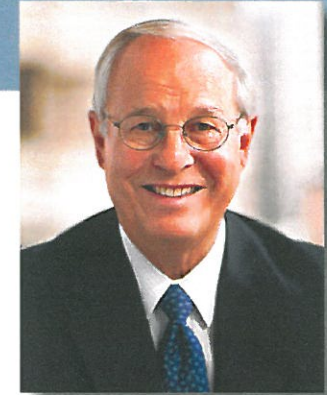
